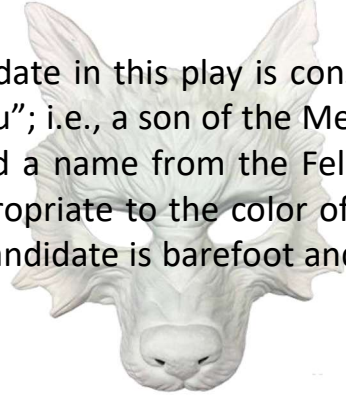


THE FC CANDIDATE
